BBA in Australia: Eligibility Criteria and Admission Requirements

BBA colleges in Australia accept applications twice a year for summer and Winter semesters. Some of them accept on a rolling basis. You can apply to these universities by visiting their official website. However, to get admission at BBA in Australia for Indian students, you need to meet some eligibility criteria, which include.

- High School Certificate
- SAT/ ACT Scores
- English Proficiency Scores
- Visa Requirements

Let's discuss each of them one by one!

• High School Certificate

The most common requirement for admission to BBA in Australia as an international student is to have a high school certificate. You must have completed your 12th education with a minimum of 70% to get admission into top BBA colleges in Australia.

• SAT/ ACT Scores

The Standardised test scores such as **SAT** or **ACT** are optional for getting admission to BBA programs in Australia. These test scores can be used in your admission evaluation process.

• English Proficiency Scores

If you are from a non-English speaking country, you must provide your English language proficiency scores to be considered for admission. This is one of the most important requirements for admission to BBA in Australia for Indian students as well. The minimum expected scores of two popular tests are

- **IELTS** overall minimum: 6.0 - 6.5
- **TOEFL**: 80 - 100

• Visa Requirements

As an international student seeking admission to Australian BBA colleges, you will have to apply for a **student visa for Australia**. You must apply for your visa at least 3 months prior to the start date of your BBA program in Australia.

Documents Required to Study BBA in Australia

There are some other essential documents that you must submit in your application to be on the safest side. Here is a list of documents that you must prepare before submitting your application form:

- Official High School Transcripts
- English Language Proficiency Scores
- SAT or ACT test scores
- Personal Statement or Essay
- **Statement of Purpose**
- **Letter of Recommendation**
- Proof of Financial Resources
- Copy of your Passport

Make sure you must visit the official university website to check the additional documents of the course based on your country.

Cost of Studying BBA in Australia

The overall BBA in Australia fees for international students will depend on two factors which are your tuition fees and the lifestyle you live. Let's discuss them in detail:

• Tuition Fees

The BBA fees in Australia for an international student will vary from one university to another and the choice of course. The average Australia BBA fees ranges from 15,000 AUD/ INR 8,19,019 which can go up to 38,000 AUD/ INR 20,74,848 or more per year.

• Costs of Living

Apart from the BBA fees in Australia, the other cost is your living cost. On average, you are required to spend between 900 AUD to 1,675 AUD/ INR 49,141 to 91,457 per month on your accommodation costs. This may include your personal expenses too.

Scholarships for BBA in Australia

If pursuing a degree in BBA in Australia cost seems high, you can also apply for some scholarships to manage your BBA fees in Australia. Various types of scholarships, both university-specific and external scholarships are awarded to needy students for their studies.
