BSc Nursing in UK: Course Guide for Indian Students

BSc Nursing in UK is a 3-year program, offered in over 50 universities in the country. The average cost of pursuing a BSc Nursing in UK ranges between 16,000-30,000 GBP which is equivalent to 14 to 27 lakhs for international students. International students may have to rely on private and government scholarship schemes and loans to aid their education.

The University of Manchester, Kings College of London, and University of Edinburgh rank among the [top nursing universities in UK](#). Along with internship opportunities, these universities yield a high return on investment as well. BSc Nursing in UK graduates earn around 24,000 GBP (22 lakhs INR) as trainees. An experienced professional with 2 to 5 years of working background can earn an annual salary between 60,000 to 109,000 GBP (55-99 lakhs INR). According to a survey, about 94% of BSc Nursing graduates get employment within six months post-completion of the course.

What is BSc Nursing?

BSc in Nursing imparts knowledge on recent research, practices, and policies related to the field of Nursing. The study covers a variety of specializations like Adult Nursing, Children's Nursing, Mental Health Nursing, and Midwifery. Students will develop clinical skills throughout the course.

The program also involves training in clinical ward areas, theatre and recovery, and infection control.

- **International Enrollment:** The UK is the leader in the field of medical sciences and subjects allied with medicine. According to a survey, 22,045 international students opted for subjects allied with medicine in the UK.
- **NHS Benefits:** Working with NHS (National Healthcare Service) in UK will guarantee the below-mentioned benefits:
 - Long-term contract.
 - 27 paid holidays.
 - Decent salary to start with i.e., 22,128 GBP.
 - Paid training.
 - 37.5 hours of fixed standard weekly work hours.
- **Work-while-study:** UK Universities will allow the students to work for 20 hours each week and work full-time during public holidays. This policy will help them gain experience and cover some of the expenses.
- **Internships:** The UK also offers scope for getting trained in a variety of clinical & medical areas and other specialities. This helps to get an internship and full-time opportunities for course completion.
- **Scope:** There is a massive demand for nurses in the UK in recent times and the job opportunities are endless. Skilled students can work as Children Nurse, Mental Health Nurse, Health Visitors, Therapists and many more with an average salary of 29.62 lakhs INR per year.

BSc Nursing in UK: Admission Requirements

A good score in English and Mathematics at 10 + 2 level is required to apply for BSc Nursing in UK. Students have to submit the following documents as well.

- 10th & 12th mark sheets equivalent to the US education system.
- Good scores in English and Mathematics, Biology, Physics, and other science subjects.
- An updated Resume
- 2 letters of recommendation
- Passport-sized photos, passport & valid ID proof
- Statement of purpose
- English proficiency test scores (IELTS or TOEFL)

Documents Required for Visa Application in the UK

International students need the following documents to apply for UK student visa below:

- Passport and its photocopy
- A recent photograph
- Mark sheets of 10th & 12th
- IELTS/TOEFL/PTE scores as proof of English proficiency
- Financial statements
- A non-EU or Swiss student may have to provide an ATAS certificate.
- Financial Statements must be submitted as proof that students can afford the bare minimum living expenditure, which is GBP 1,015 per month outside London, and GBP 1,265 in London.

Cost of Studying BSc Nursing in UK

Cost of studying abroad consists of three types of expenses: Pre-departure Cost, Tuition Fees, and Cost of Living in the UK.

BSc Nursing in UK Tuition Costs

The cost of studying Nursing in UK can be from 14 lakhs to 24 lakhs per year. The course duration is generally 3 years. The below table shows the tuition fees of top Nursing universities in UK.

Scope after BSc Nursing in UK

After BSc Nursing completion, students can make 22 lakhs INR per year initially. This salary will rise by at least 36% with more than five years of experience. With more experience & qualifications, international students can earn between 60,000-109,000 GBP (55-99 lakhs INR) per annum. Can I work in UK after BSc Nursing?

Students can practice and work as a nurse for at least two years post-completion of the course. The new visa rule allows one to search for job opportunities and work for 2 years after completing the degree.

After completing the BSc Nursing in UK, students can pursue further studies in MSc in Nursing. One can specialize in subjects like advanced clinical practice and medical decision-making, critical care nursing, and many other subjects. Students can take direct admission to the Master's course if they have pursued a bachelor's degree from the same college in nursing. The University of

Manchester grants a fee waiver as well in this case. Here students may enjoy a 10% reduction in tuition fees while pursuing MSc after completing BSc in Nursing.
