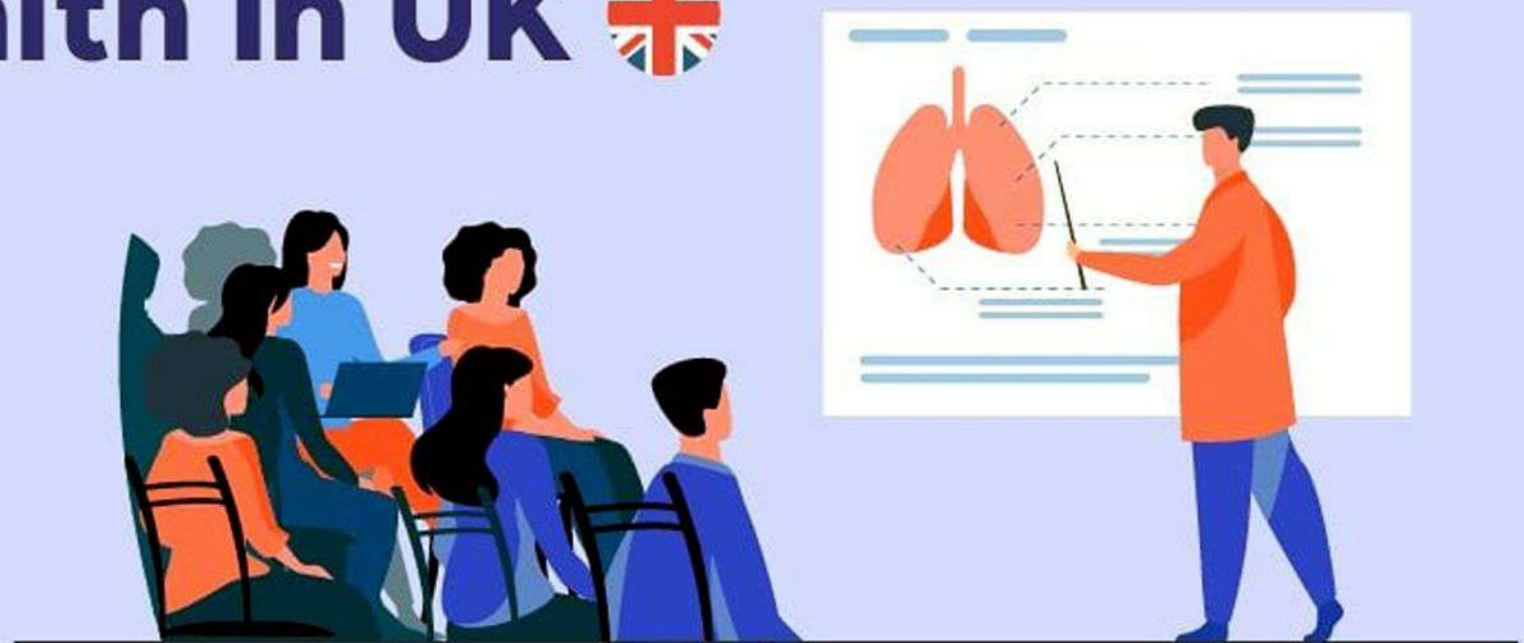

Masters in Public Health in UK take a duration of **10 months to 24 months** to complete. It is an interdisciplinary field that deals with the general well being of the world by promoting good hygiene and preventing diseases. The degree is also offered as a part-time and distance learning course in the UK universities and costs around **19,000 to 35,000 GBP**. For Indian students, the cost of studying in UK approximates **18.33 lakhs to 33.77 lakhs INR**.

Masters in Public Health is expanded to various disciplines such as epidemiology, health education, health economics, mental health, and occupational health safety. It is an extension of the healthcare program in UK universities. The average salary earned by a public health graduate in the UK is approximately **30,000 GBP** per annum (~**28 lakhs INR**). Students with a degree in masters in public health in UK can work as emergency health responders, biostatisticians, epidemiologists, health education teachers, health and safety advisors, nutritionists, etc.

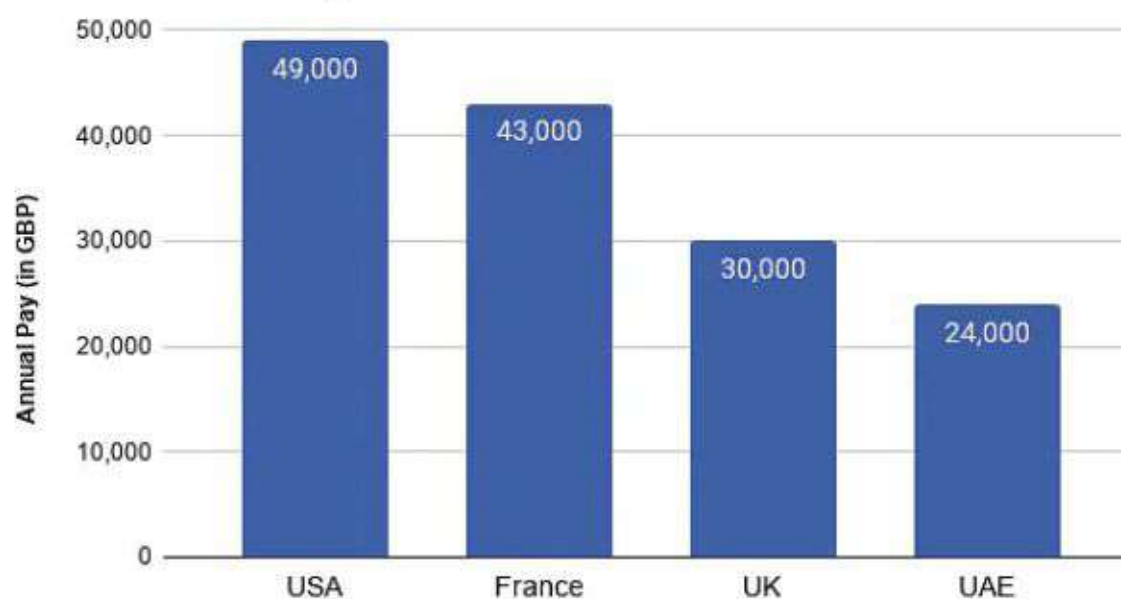

### Why Study Masters in Public Health in UK?

Public Health is part of the healthcare industry and focuses on taking care of the well-being of the population. Some of the reasons for pursuing masters of public health in UK are discussed below:

- According to QS News World Ranking for 2022, three of the universities offering masters in public health in the UK are included in the top 10 list.
- Public Health workers in the UK are third-highest paid in the world with an average annual salary of 30,000 GBP.

### Salary of Public Health Workers



- Senior managers working in the public health domain get the highest pay of 56,000 GBP per annum on an average.
- The course can be complete within a year in the UK. However, [masters in public health in Canada](#) or any other country take approximately two years to complete.

### Masters in Public Health in UK: Course Details

Public Health is an interdisciplinary course that encompasses several other specializations. The basic course structure is built to tackle public health challenges through research and practice. Masters of public health's numerous disciplines hinge around basic and core courses such as:

- Principles of Public Health
- Introduction to statistical methods
- Introduction to epidemiology
- Principles of social research, amongst others.

Preliminarily, students have to study some compulsory core modules before they can focus on their choice of stream or specialization. They may also choose to follow a general public health program. Students having little or no basic computer skills are required to study computer science as a supplementary course. The global health lecture series and seminar are also part of the supplementary modules.

## Admission Process for Masters in Public Health in UK

Applicants opting to pursue [masters in the UK universities](#) in public health must have a bachelors degree in dental, clinical, medical or related field with an overall minimum 60% academic score.

**Where to Apply:** You are required to visit the university's webpage or the program page to submit the application. Some institutions accept application via [UCAS](#) portal.

## Eligibility for Masters of Public Health Admission

- Hold a 2:1 or an upper second class (equivalent to an average of 60% to 70%) in a dental, clinical or medical bachelor's degree from a reputable or globally recognized institution.
- Students from nursing, health or social science background are also considered for admissions.
- Relevant work experience.
- Evidence of ability in mathematics or basic computer skills.

## Documents Required for Masters of Public Health in UK Admission

- Transcripts showing full details of subjects and grades offered in the previous institutions are required.
- Photocopies of all official certificates.
- Official English translation of certificates and transcripts
- One or more references/recommendation letters
- Curriculum Vitae
- Evidence of English language proficiency
- Course-specific required documents
- A copy of the passport or photo page of the passport.
- Statement of purpose

## Cost of Studying Masters in Public Health in UK

Funds required for [studying abroad](#) can be distributed into three categories: pre-arrival cost, the cost of study and the cost of living. These expenses are further discussed in brief in this section.

### Pre-arrival Cost

Those expenses which are incurred even before arrival to the university are known as pre-arrival expenses. A summary of such one-time cost tabulated below:

## Tuition Fees of Masters of Public Health in the UK

The annual tuition fee of masters in public health in the UK starts from **19,000 GBP** and can go as high as **29,220 GBP**. Imperial College London is the only university whose annual tuition fees exceed 30,000 GBP. London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine has the lowest tuition fee of 19,000 GBP per year. The tuition fees for pursuing masters in public health from top UK universities for Indian students is detailed below:

## Job Prospects for Masters in Public Health in UK

According to a report published by the government of the UK, over 1.9 million people are working in the healthcare industry including both public and private sector. Public health is one of the fields of choice for them. After the outbreak of the Covid-19, the significance of the Public Health professionals has become more prominent across the globe.

Around **88%** of this workforce in the UK is domestic, **6%** is from EU and **6%** from non-EU nations. The average salary offered here is **30,000 GBP per annum**. ## Eligibility Criteria to Study Master in Public Health in UK
